With heartfelt gratitude, we thank our incredible sponsors, donors, school partners, and community supporters who continue to believe in our vision and help us bring it to life.

In just six months into 2025, Love4Animals has:

- Installed its first-ever chicken coop at Chapel Hill Elementary, launching an innovative hands-on classroom pet and curriculum program.
- Donated 7 to 12 fish tanks to classrooms across the district to promote empathy, responsibility, and environmental awareness through animal care.
- Partnered with five schools, reaching students where they can learn and grow; creating safe spaces for animal education and emotional development.
- Served over 400 students through in-school programming, pop-up animal safety classes, and interactive learning experiences.
- Provided support to over 300 families through our Community Outreach Program, offering resources ranging from pet food and supplies to direct care and emergency assistance.
